

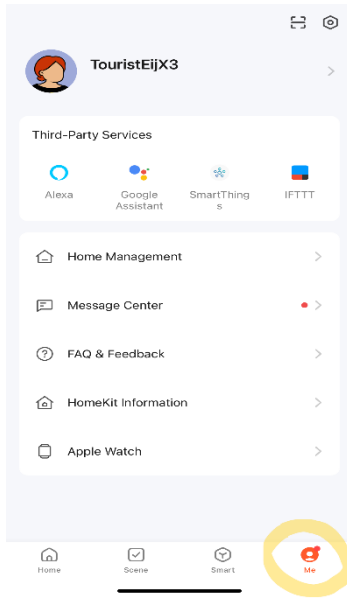
Connecting your A-Ok Motors to your phone via Bluetooth

First of all make sure all your motors have their limits set and are working perfectly with the remotes supplied.

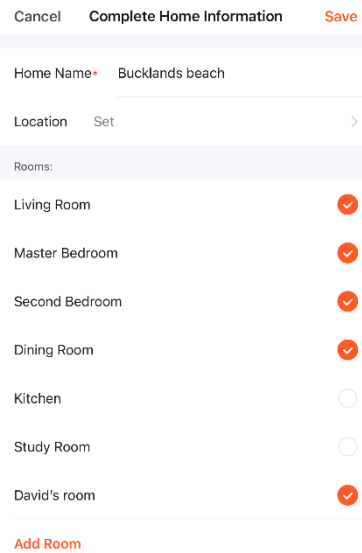
Download “Tuya Smart” from the App or play store

Once opened please sign up to Tuya and allow Bluetooth and location access.

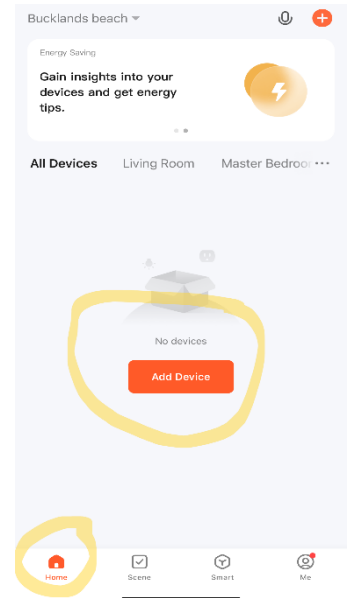
Step 1) – Select “Me” on the bottom right and select “Home Management”



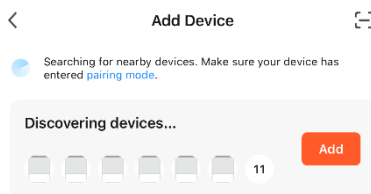
Step 2) – Select “My Home ..” Go in and change the home name and go into “Room Management to sort out your house rooms”



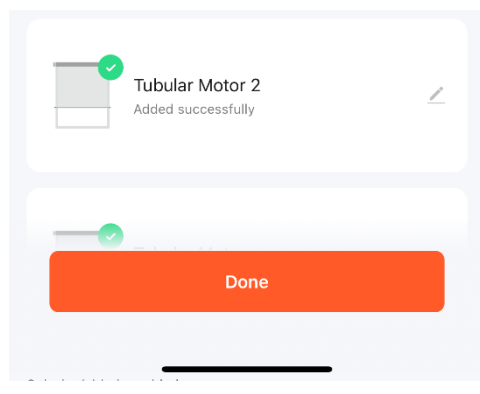
Step 3) – Go back to the home screen and select “Home” – Then go to “Add Device”



Step 4) Your app should be picking up the close blinds – Select “ADD”



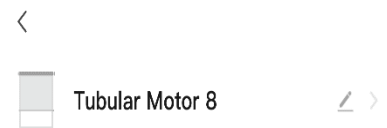
Step 5) Once added, press the “Done” button.



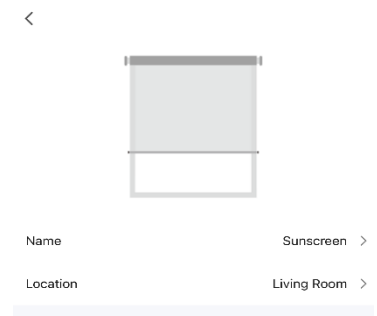
Step 6) Your motors should show up now on your main screen. Make sure all your blinds around the house are at the open position (At the top). Go into the first room you want to sort out and set the blinds to around halfway. This will let you distinguish the blinds which are in this room. Click on each “Tubular motor” until one shows the blind is halfway. Click the up or down arrow to see what blind moves.



Step 7) Select the Edit button on the blind then again click the edit button one more time (Always top right)

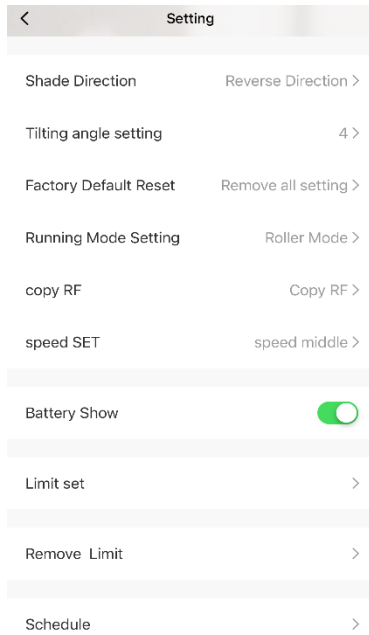


You can now edit the Name and location of this blind.

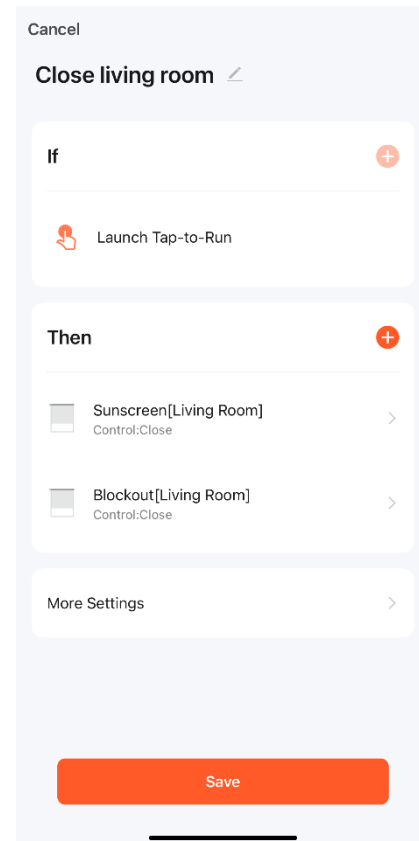


Repeat for each blind in that room and then move onto the next room and repeat

You now have additional options you can use. You get there by selecting the “More” when controlling a blind. We recommend showing the battery percentage. We do not recommend going into “Limit set or Remove Limit” as this will alter where the motor stops and starts. This also effects the way the remote works with the motor. The slower the motor speed, the quieter it will be.



You can now also create scenes for blinds. You must remember these will only work when the phone is near the blinds as its connected via Bluetooth. Follow the on-screen prompts on what scenes you would like to create.



A few example scenes:

Close all blinds in one room.

Close blinds to a particular percentage that makes watching TV better.

General nighttime scene that closes all blinds.

General Morning scene that opens all blinds.

You will get a prompt below on what blinds worked in the scene
